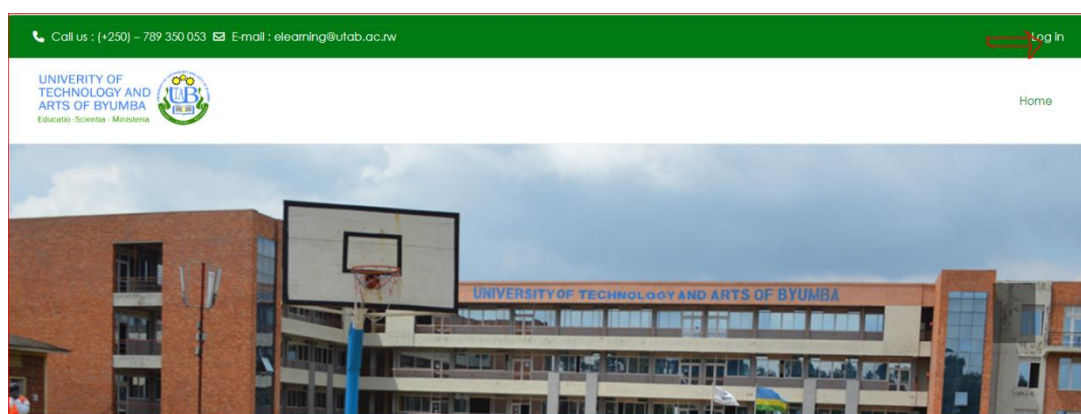

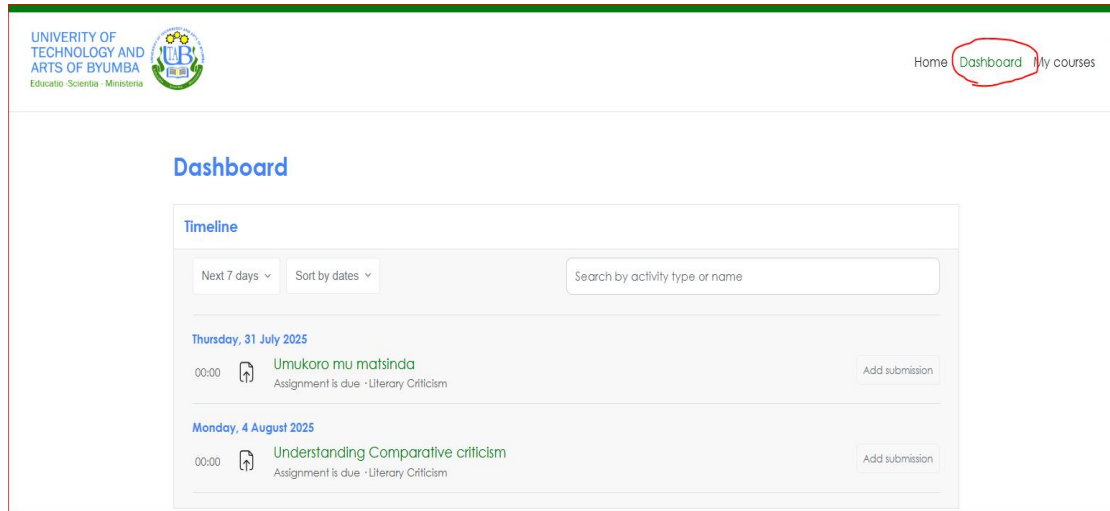

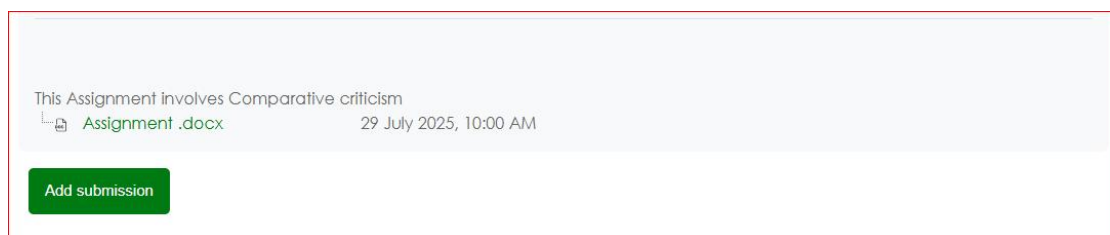
PART 2: How to access, submit or delete assignment on E-Learning



Step 1: when you click on dashboard the activities will be displayed and click on it.

Or you can click on my courses and navigate your course, Links to assignments is found under the topic course page and click on it to read or download it

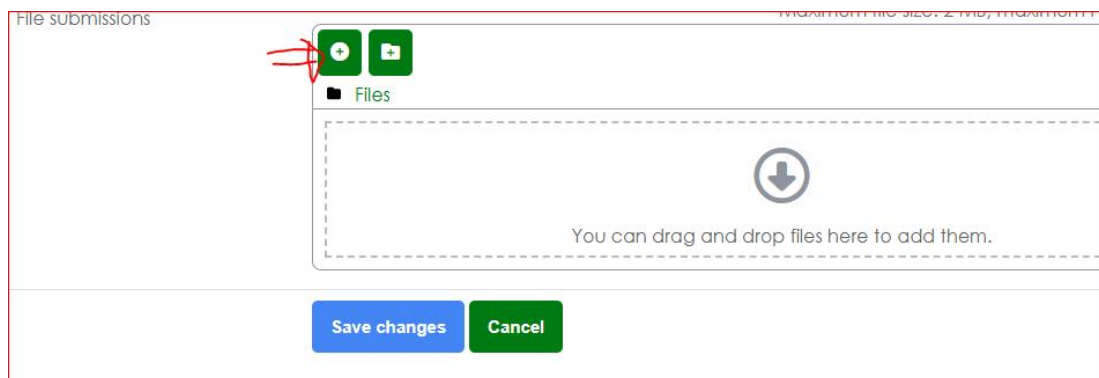
Step 2: Click on Add submission button. The Assignment submission page will open. Depending on how your instructor set up the assignment, you may have the option to upload and submit file(s), enter text in a text entry box or both.



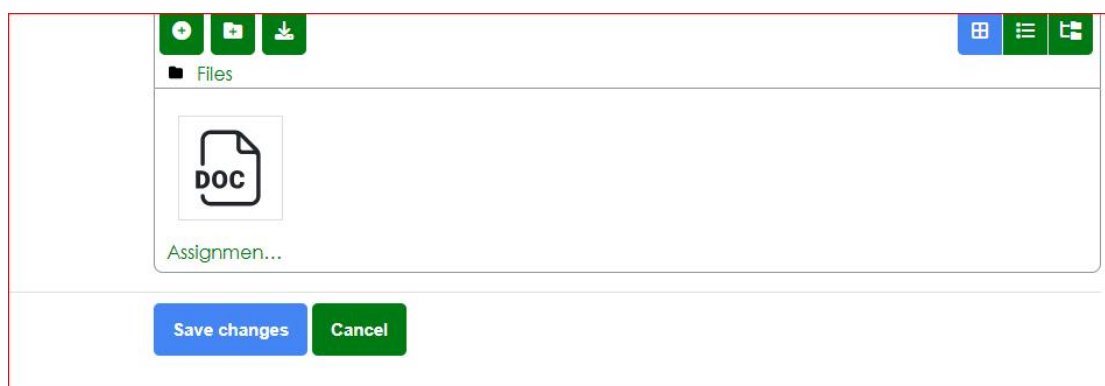
Note: It should be noted that if you are submitting the assignment after the deadline, the "Add submission" button might not show up. If so, contact your lecturer about what to do next.

click on add submission and navigate a file you created as your assignment from your device(computer or etc), then open it and upload

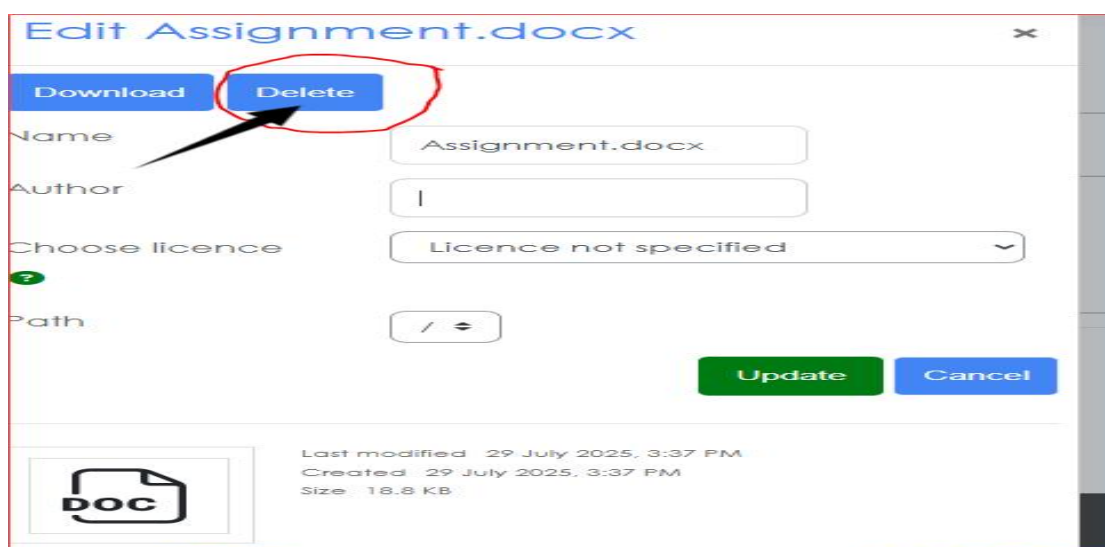


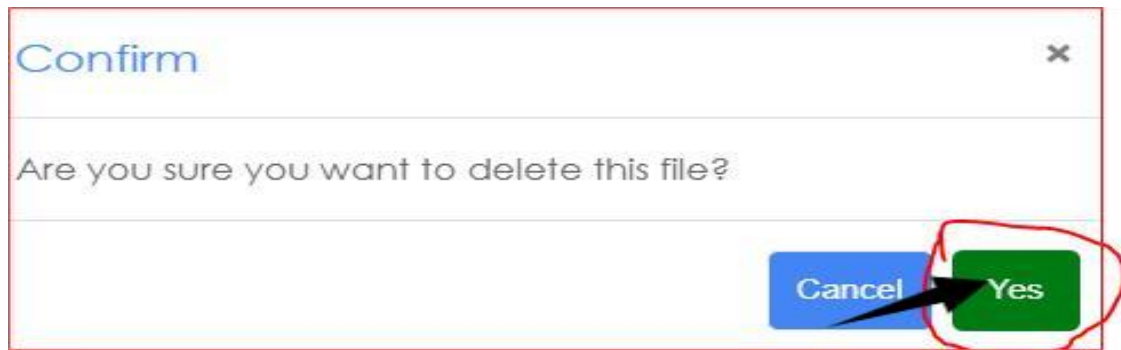
Once you upload your assignment click on save changes

Then click on delete

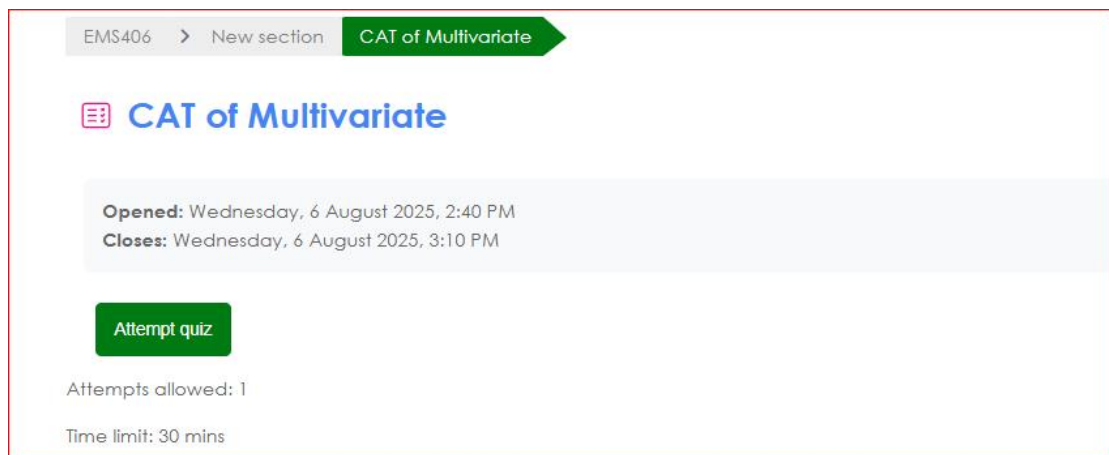
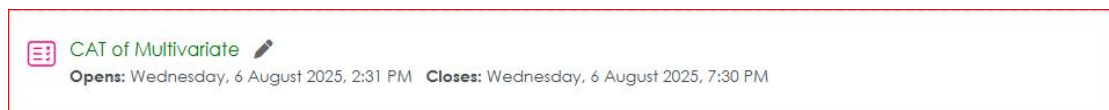




Confirm if you want to delete you file by clicking on Yes, you file will be automatically remove to the file submission.
